INFORMATIONAL ITEMS

will be observing the drill and we need numbers of check-ins. ARES net will be called up using the fanout list.

4. NON-EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS Ade, K9DHR discussed the THEDA CLARK RUN. He also discussed the use of ARRL numbered radiograms for health and welfare messages. These can be used during the drill on Tuesday.
