INFORMATIONAL ITEMS

1. VOLUNTEER EXAMS -Larry, KD9IA reported that next exam session will be August 13 at Green Bay Swapfest. The VEC Team was at Tomahawk on June 12. Our VEC team was one of 250 from total 5000 chosen to be a Field Stock Station - we keep our own supply of tests, forms etc. Tests are scheduled for Appleton on Sept 10 and Dec 10.
2. EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS - Wayne, WD9FLJ discussed the hazardous materials course to be given 5/21. He also stated that the ARES net meets Wed PM - anyone living in Outagamie County and wishing to join should see him. (If you live in another county and want to help their ARES group would like you to join.)

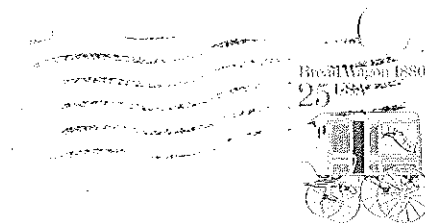
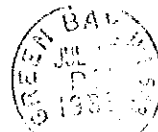
