SUBJECT: Local Area Repeaters (a news item for your usage)

A review of the local repeaters: namely, 145.15, 145.21, 145.33PL and 146.76. These four complement each other in this area and three of them are open repeaters. The only operation on "PL" (tone squelch 107.2Hz) is 145.33 which shares the same site as 146.76 that being rural Chilton, WI. 145.33 is a good place to test your "PL" and a good backup unit giving wide area coverage and best of all very little usage. 145.33/146.76 are owned by Fox Valley VHF Assoc. which is supported by its members. .76 is currently off the air for updating, which include a pre-amp offering .19Mv sensitivity. By July 3rd the new feed line, (\$1600) will be installed as well as a new off-set bracket and antenna. This hopefully to coincide with the repair/update of 146.76.

The idea of a phone patch is 146.76 is not at all practical due to the wide area coverage and location away from the fox cities. It would offer the possibility of using a phone patch from a base, thus circumventing normal long distance lines-----a NO-NO with the licensee and the FCC.

145.15 a local repeater owned by Aide Van^{Der}Den Burgt and supported by its user members. Who have in addition a phone patch usage in our local area. .15 does a very adequate job with local coverage and with its phone patch (not for business/only personal) truly is an additional benefit.

145.21 is privately owned by Bob Ronk, KB9IE and is a wide area repeater which is generally open and has inter-connects via 220 and other functions coming on line. Bob, enjoys technical aspect of repeaters and a great asset to our repeater family. (also the tech. person for .33/76)

In short, we need all the repeaters in our area as they fulfill a function for communications from rag-chew to traffic handling to public service and foremost emergency. The one thing they all have in common is the need for your support .

145.33/146.76 will have its annual meeting on August 16th at 7:00PM at The Riverside INN, Menasha. It will be your chance to support Fox Valley VHF Assoc. and be a part of its future. We will be sending out a meeting notice in the 2nd week of July to the total membership of 145.15, 145.33/146.76 and the FCARC group.

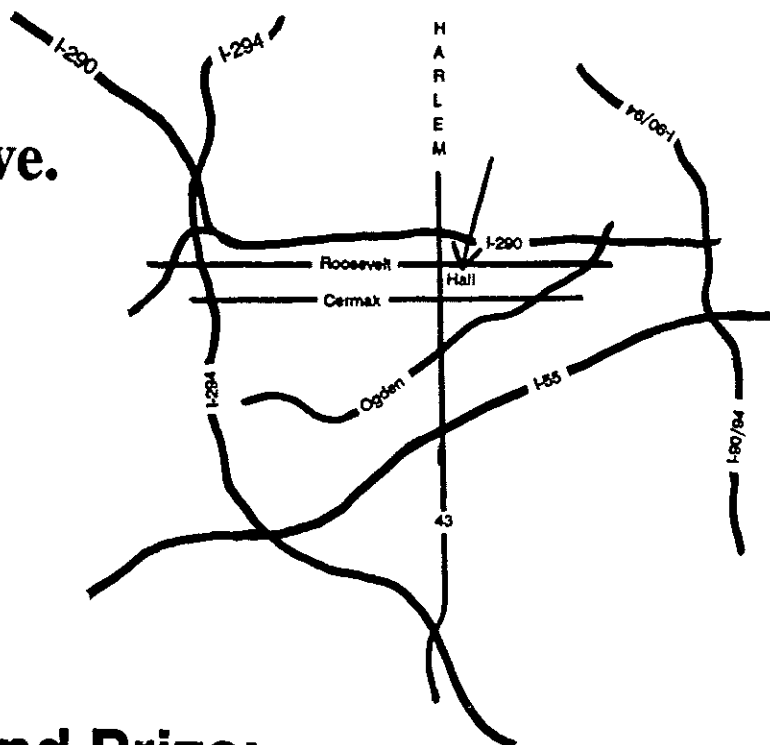
