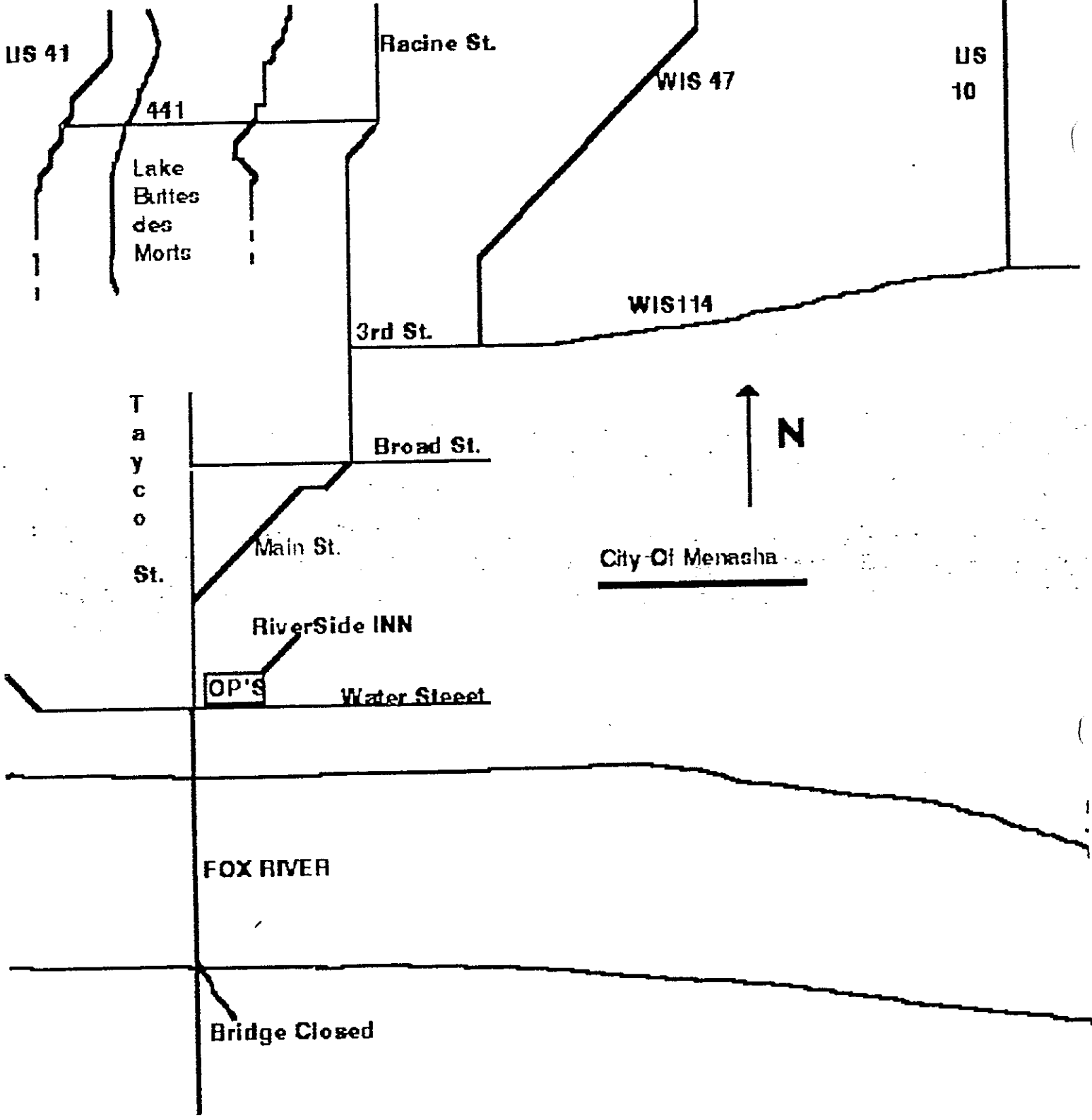

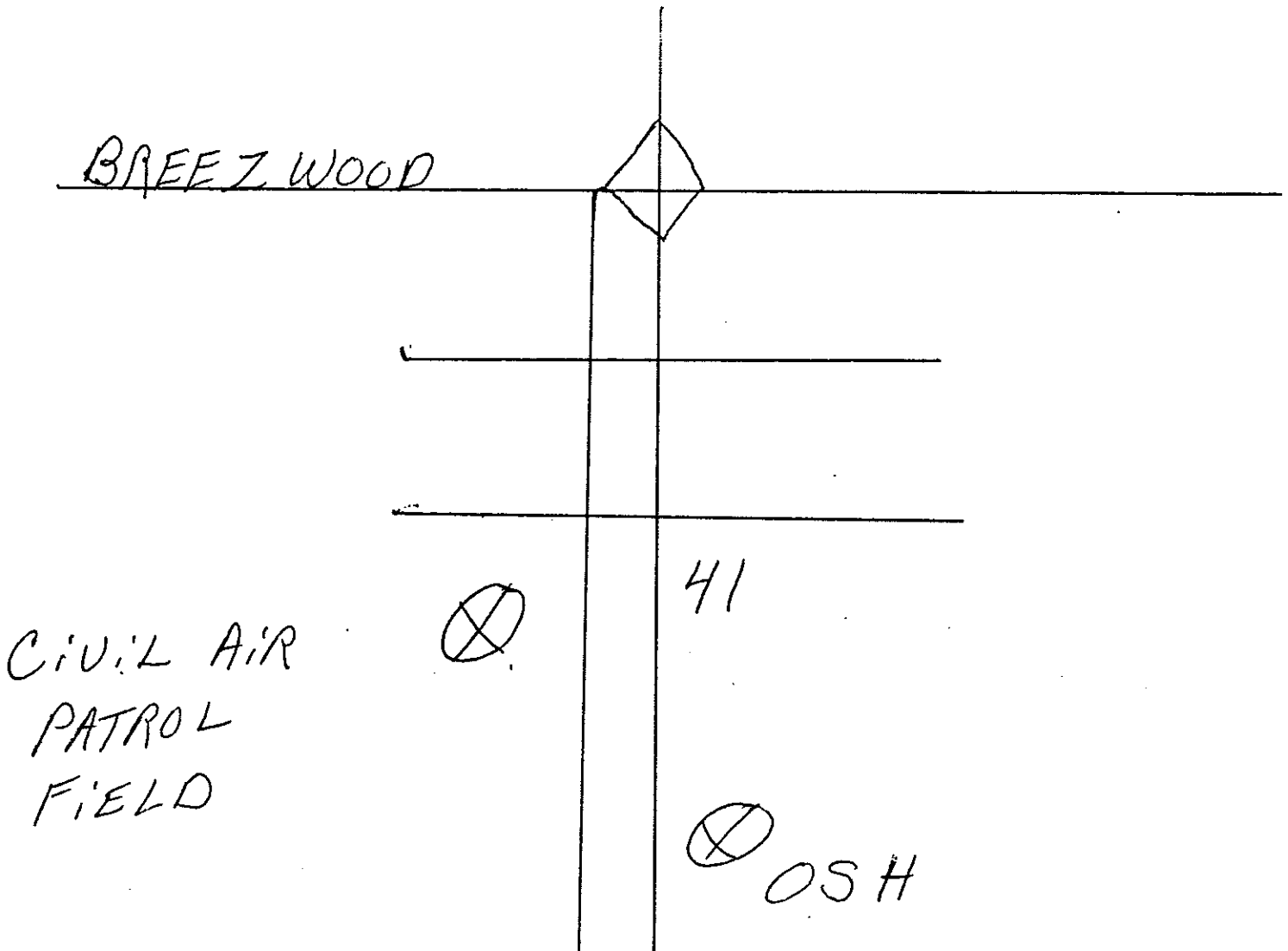


FIELD DAY 1990
