III. THE AMATEUR IS PROGRESSIVE. HE KEEPS HIS STATION ABREAST OF SCIENCE. IT IS BUILT WELL AND EFFICIENTLY. HIS OPERATING PRACTICE IS CLEAN AND REGULAR.

IV. THE AMATEUR IS FRIENDLY. SLOW AND PATIENT SENDING WHEN REQUESTED, FRIENDLY ADVICE AND COUNSEL TO THE BEGINNER, KINDLY ASSISTANCE AND COOPERATION FOR THE BROADCAST LISTENER: THESE ARE MARKS OF THE AMATEUR SPIRIT.

V. THE AMATEUR IS BALANCED. RADIO IS HIS HOBBY. HE NEVER ALLOWS IT TO INTERFERE WITH ANY OF THE DUTIES HE OWES TO HIS HOME, HIS JOB, HIS SCHOOL OR HIS COMMUNITY.

VI. THE AMATEUR IS PATRIOTIC. HIS KNOWLEDGE AND HIS STATION ARE ALWAYS READY FOR THE SERVICE OF HIS COUNTRY AND HIS COMMUNITY.

## ARRL BULLETIN

THE FCC, ON APRIL 29 ISSUED ITS FINAL REPORT AND ORDER IN PR DOCKET 89-552, ADOPTING RULES FOR THE USE OF 220 THROUGH 222 MHZ. BY THE PRIVATE LAND MOBILE SERVICE. AMATEURS WILL BE REQUIRED TO DISCONTINUE ALL OPERATIONS IN THE 220 THROUGH 222 MHZ. BAND EFFECTIVE 0000 UTC AUGUST 28TH 1991, WHICH IS 8PM EDT AUGUST 27TH.

OLD-STYLE FCC LICENSES WILL FADE AWAY IN A FEW YEARS AS THE COMMISSION REPLACES THEM WITH LASER-PRINTED TICKETS. THE NEW LICENSES BEGAN APPEARING IN MID-APRIL: A "WALLET CARD" SLIGHTLY SMALLER THAN THE TRADITIONAL TICKET AND A 5 \* 7 INCH DOCUMENT SUITABLE FOR FRAMING FOR YOUR SHACK. A CAVEAT, HOWEVER: LASER INK CAN SMEAR, SO LAMINATING YOUR WALLET-SIZE LICENSE MIGHT BE PRUDENT. FROM QST..
