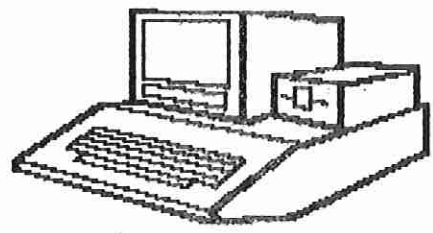

COMPUTER GENERATED EXAMS

LARRY SIEBERS KD9IA (VE TEAM CONTACT) HAS RECENTLY RECEIVED FROM THE ARRL A COMPUTER DISK WITH ALL THE EXAMS AND FORMS ON IT. HE IS IN THE PROCESS OF WORKING ON GENERATING OUR EXAMS (LOCALLY) AS WE NEED THEM. IT DOES REQUIRE A LARGE AMOUNT OF PAPER BUT, IT MAY IN THE LONG RUN MAKE IT MORE EASY FOR US, SINCE WE WILL NOT HAVE TO ORDER THE ACTUAL EXAMS FROM THE ARRL. THE COMPUTER GENERATES EVERYTHING (INCLUDING CODE TESTS) BUT THE CSCE, THOSE STILL HAVE TO BE ORDERED FROM THE ARRL.

DURING OUR SESSION ON AUGUST 10 WE WILL TRY FOR THE FIRST TIME, MULTIPLE CHOICE CODE TESTING. THAT IS ALLOWED AND THE NEW COMPUTER PROGRAM WILL GENERATE THOSE EXAMS. THOSE CANDIDATES TAKING THE MORSE CODE TESTS MAY FIND THE MULTIPLE CHOICE TO BE SOMEWHAT EASIER? WE DONT KNOW FOR SURE YET. IT WILL BE INTERESTING TO SEE IF THE PASS RATE GOES UP!!

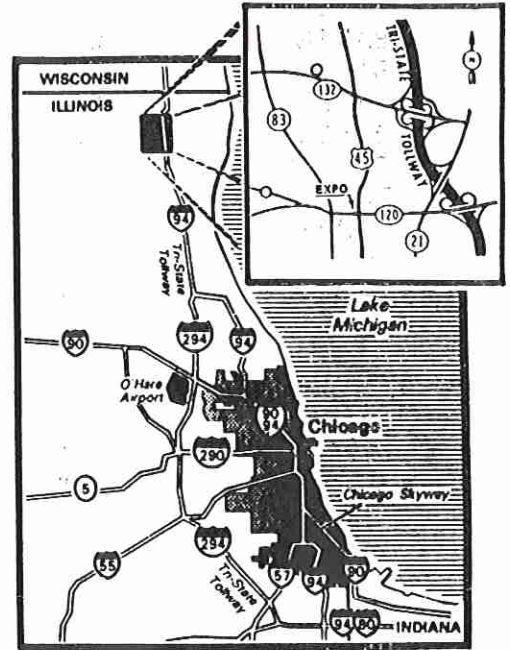

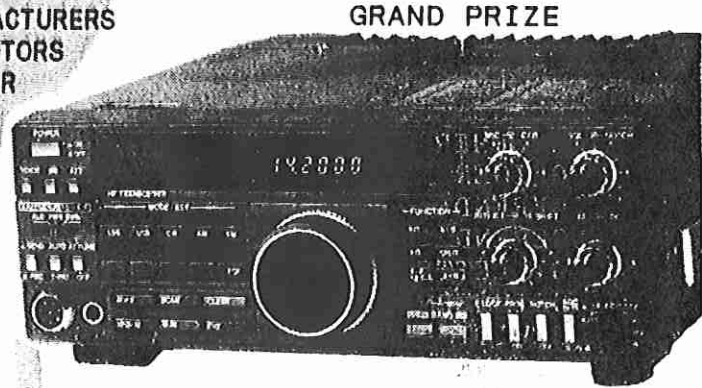
