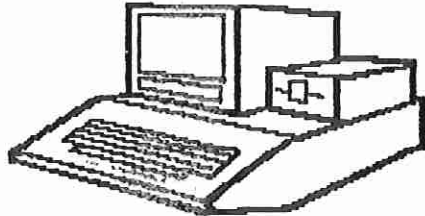

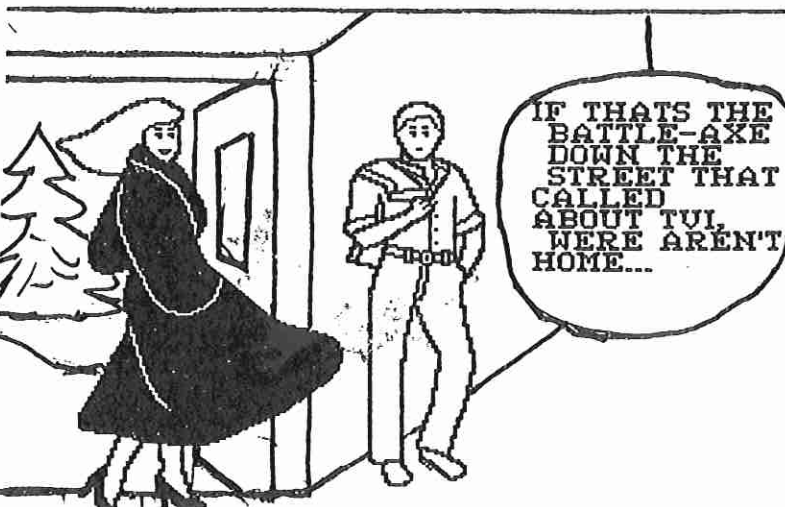

NO AMATEUR LICENSE FEES?

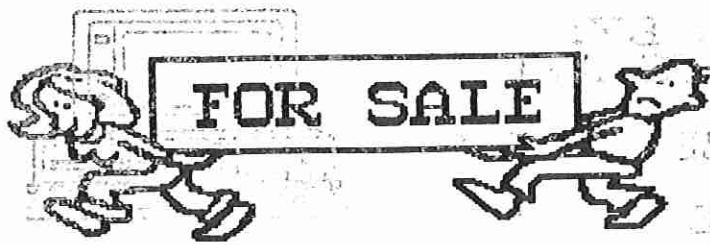
FEES FOR AMATEUR LICENSES TOOK ANOTHER STEP TOWARD OBLIVION ON JULY 30, WHEN THE HOUSE ENERGY AND COMMERCE COMMITTEE PASSED H.R. 1674, THE FCC AUTHORIZATION BILL, AND SENT IT UP TO THE FULL HOUSE. THE BILL SPECIFICALLY EXEMPTS AMATEUR RADIO LICENSES FROM USERS FEES. THE FULL HOUSE IS EXPECTED TO CONSIDER THE BILL AFTER ITS AUGUST RECESS. THE SENATE COMMERCE, SCIENCE AND TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE IS EXPECTED TO TAKE UP ITS VERSION OF H.R. 1674 (S. 1132) SOMETIME IN EARLY SEPTEMBER.

WHO DIVIDES THE SPECTRUM?

THE PROCESS OF DECIDING WHO GETS TO USE THE RADIO SPECTRUM, AND FOR WHAT PURPOSE, TAKES PLACE AT MANY LEVELS. SOME DECISIONS ARE MADE BY INTERNATIONAL TREATIES AND AGREEMENTS, PRIMARILY AMONG MEMBERS OF THE INTERNATIONAL TELECOMMUNICATIONS UNION (ITU). THIS IS NECESSARY BECAUSE RADIO WAVES DON'T RECOGNIZE INTERNATIONAL BORDERS. THE ITU STARTED TO FOCUS ON HOW TO DIVIDE THE RADIO SPECTRUM IN THE EARLY 1900'S. MANY INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCES HAVE BEEN HELD SINCE THAT TIME TO ADDRESS CHANGES TO KEEP PACE WITH USERS NEEDS AND CHANGES IN TECHNOLOGY.

OTHER DECISIONS ARE MADE BY NATIONAL TELECOMMUNICATIONS REGULATING BODIES. IN OUR CASE THE FEDERAL COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION (FCC) IS RESPONSIBLE FOR REGULATING ALL US TELECOMMUNICATIONS EXCEPT THOSE OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT. THE FCC HAS THE MONUMENTAL TASK OF LISTENING TO EVERYONE FROM THE PRIVATE SECTOR WHO WANTS TO USE THE RADIO SPECTRUM AND TRYING TO ALLOCATE SPACE FOR THEM.

GETTYSBURG, PA. 17325-7245 AND REQUEST A FORM 1010-B VERIFICATION LETTER VERIFYING THAT YOU WERE LICENSED AS A TECHNICIAN CLASS PRIOR TO 3/21/87. AFTER YOU RECEIVE THAT FORM FROM THE FCC, BRING IT TO THE TEST SESSION WITH YOU IN ORDER TO CLAIM YOUR DESERVED CREDIT.

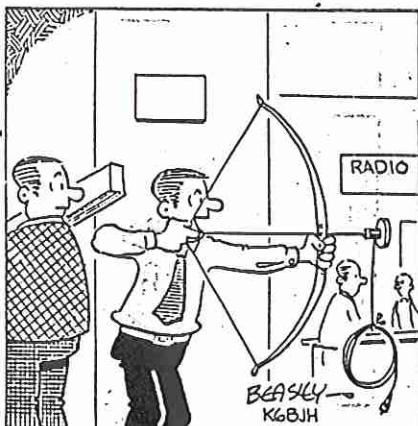

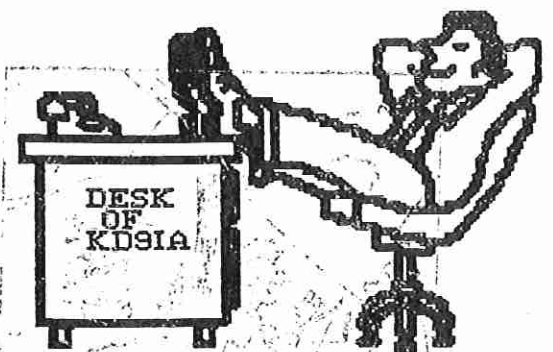
