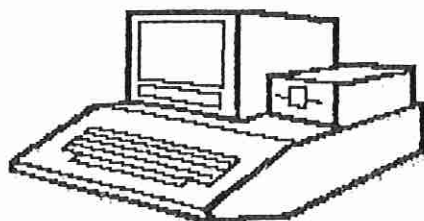

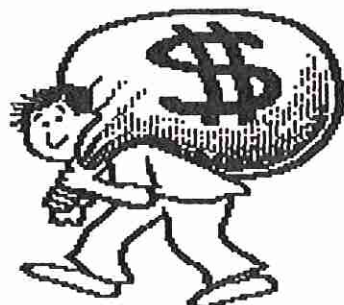

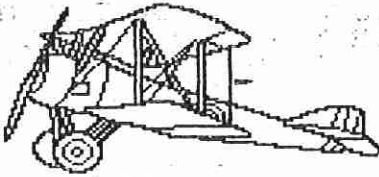

3. PLAQUE FOR SILENT KEYS.

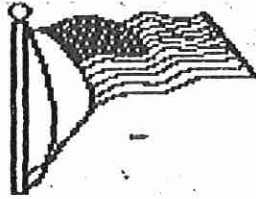

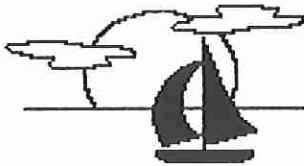

## THE AMATEURS

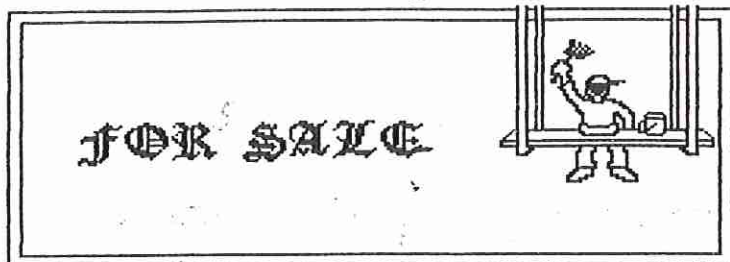
