FOX HUNT

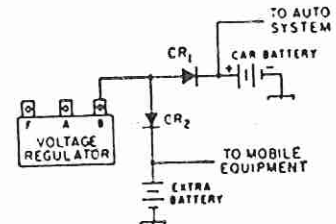

Diode-Switching Mobile Batteries

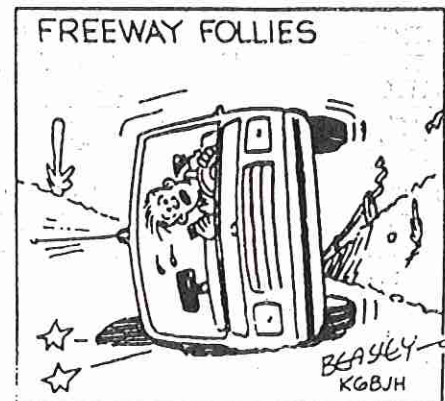
The battery system shown in the following figure is useful in mobile work when it is desired to keep the car's electrical system isolated from the mobile equipment. In this plan, an extra battery is installed to power the mobile

equipment. Although the car's charging system the accessory battery up to par, the mobile equipment draws only from the spare battery, leaving the car battery to perform its regular duties. All of this is done without any mechanical switching.

The system shown requires two silicon diodes, CR 1, CR 2, and the extra battery. The two diodes are connected so that the car alternator will supply both batteries with charging current through the regulator circuit but neither battery can feed current back to the voltage regulator circuit or to the other battery. The forward voltage drop across the diodes is somewhere around 0.7v, so it may be necessary to have the voltage regulator circuit advanced about 1 additional volt. The diodes used were a 70A, 50 p-i-v unit. Most diodes will operate at temperatures up to 150 degrees C, so they can be mounted right up in the engine compartment. Of course, they must be isolated from ground and mounted on an insulated heat sink. The author used a 1/4 X 4 X 4 inch aluminum sink for each diode. 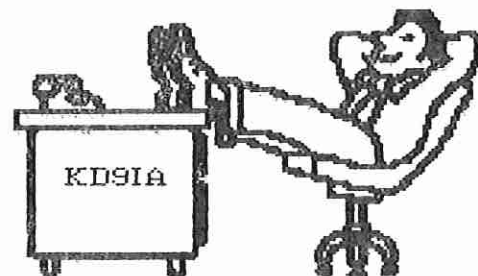
ELECTIONS WERE THEN DECLARED CLOSED..
