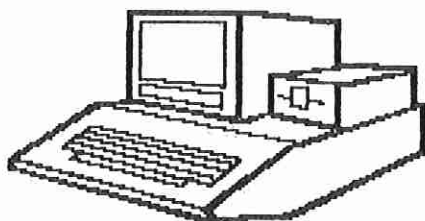

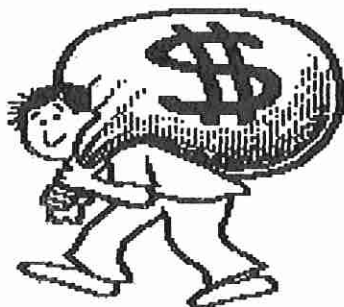

EDUCATION COMMITTEE

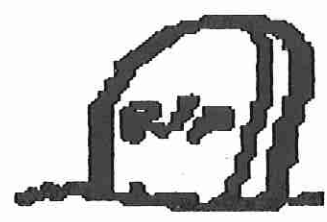

-----BOY SCOUT DEMO: LARRY , KD9IA REPORTED TO THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE RADIO DEMONSTRATION THAT WAS PRESENTED TO THE MILWAUKEE GROUP OF SCOUTS. WAYNE, WD9FLJ AND CHAD, N9PRC AND LARRY, KD9IA SPENT A SATURDAY DOWN AT THE E.A.A. PUTTING 157 SCOUTS ON THE AIR. AND GIVING MOST OF THEM THERE FIRST LOOK AT AMATEUR RADIO. THIS PROVED TO BE ALOT OF WORK, BUT ALSO ALOT OF FUN.

THE NEED FOR LEGISLATION TO PROTECT AMATEUR RADIO FREQUENCIES COULD NOT BE CLEARER.

THE FEDERAL COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION AND THE CONGRESS WILL DEBATE SPECTRUM REALLOCATION EARLY NEXT YEAR. WE MUST ACT NOW TO MAKE SURE THE CONGRESS AND THE AMERICAN PEOPLE UNDERSTAND THE ROLE AMATEUR RADIO OPERATORS PLAYED DURING HURRICANES ANDREW AND INIKI. WE MUST USE EVERY OPPORTUNITY TO SHOW WHY THE FREQUENCIES ALLOCATED FOR AMATEUR RADIO OPERATORS MUST BE PROTECTED.

ALSO THE CLUB RECEIVED A LETTER FROM THE ARRL LOOKING FOR A ARRL AFFILIATED CLUB COORDINATOR. THIS PERSON IS PRIMARY CONTACT AND RESOURCE PERSON FOR EACH AMATEUR RADIO CLUB IN THE SECTION, SPECIALIZING IN MOTIVATING, PROVIDING ASSISTANCE AND COORDINATING JOINT ACTIVITIES OF RADIO CLUBS. THE ACC IS APPOINTED BY, AND REPORTS TO, THE SECTION MANAGER. DUTIES AND QUALIFICATIONS OF THE ACC INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

1. VOLUNTEER A GREAT DEAL OF TIME IN GETTING TO KNOW THE AMATEUR RADIO CLUB'S MEMBERS AND OFFICERS PERSON TO PERSON IN HIS SECTION. LEARN THEIR NEEDS, STRENGTHS AND INTERESTS AND WORK WITH THEM TO MAKE CLUB EFFECTIVE RESOURCES IN THEIR COMMUNITIES AND MORE ENJOYABLE FOR THEIR MEMBERS.

2. ENCOURAGE AFFILIATED CLUBS IN THE SECTION TO BECOME MORE ACTIVE AND, IF THE CLUB IS ALREADY HEALTHY AND EFFECTIVE, TO APPLY AS A SPECIAL SERVICE CLUB.

3. SUPPLY INTERESTED CLUBS WITH THE SPECIAL SERVICE CLUB APPLICATION FORMS.

4. ASSIST CLUBS IN COMPLETING SCC APPLICATION FORMS IF REQUESTED.

5. HELP CLUBS ESTABLISH WORKABLE PROGRAMS TO USE AS SCCs.

6. APPROVE SSC APPLICATION FORMS AND PASS THEM TO THE SM.

7. WORK WITH OTHER SECTION LEADERSHIP OFFICIALS (SECTION EMERGENCY COORDINATOR, PUBLIC INFORMATION OFFICER, TECHNICAL COORDINATOR, STATE GOVERNMENT LIAISON, ECT) TO INSURE THAT CLUBS ARE INVOLVED IN THE MAINSTREAM OF ARRL FIELD ORGANIZATION ACTIVITIES.

8. ENCOURAGE NEW CLUBS TO BECOME ARRL AFFILIATED.

9. ENSURE THAT ANNUAL PROGRESS REPORTS (UPDATE OFFICERS, LIAISON MAILING ADDRESSES ECT.) ARE FORTHCOMING FROM ALL AFFILIATED CLUBS.

10. NOVICE CLASS LICENSE; ARRL MEMBERSHIP REQUIRED.

RECRUITMENT OF NEW HAMS AND LEAGUE MEMBERS IS AN INTEGRAL PART OF THE JOB OF EVERY LEAGUE APPOINTEE. APPOINTEES SHOULD TAKE ADVANTAGE OF EVERY OPPORTUNITY TO RECRUIT A NEW HAM OR MEMBER TO FOSTER GROWTH OF FIELD ORGANIZATION PROGRAMS, AND OUR ABILITIES TO SERVE THE PUBLIC.
