Firefox Add-on "Propfire"

If you are a user of the Firefox browser, you can install a neat little add-on that will sit in the bar at the bottom of the browser screen and display propagation information. Specifically, you can monitor frequently updated A and K indices, the solar flux factor, and (if you choose), the sunspot number. A right-click on the add-on brings up a menu that provides links to sites with more information on propagation and space weather.

To get the add-on, pull down the Tools menu from the top of the screen, then select Add-ons. Select "Get add-ons" from the resulting dialog box, then do a search for "propfire" or "N0HR" (the add-on's title is N0HR Propfire). Install the add-on according to the instructions. Then you will have a constant reminder of how lousy propagation conditions are these days.
