## 443.650 Is On The Air Author: K9KI

The new 443.650 repeater has been purchased, installed, and is back on the air!

Many thanks to Rick W9RIC, the repeater committee, and several others that helped in moving of the cabinets and making things go smoothly.

The 146.76 downtown receive shares this cabinet and is also back on the air and operational.

The downtown receive uses a PL of 107.2 and gives us handheld coverage in the downtown area and some extended receive to the north and east of Appleton.

With the move of the 145.330 to its current location, the mandatory relocating of the 146.76 to the new tower, and the replacement of the 443.650, we now have 3 excellent repeaters in the Fox Valley area owned and maintained by the club.

With that we are continuing the repeater fund drive to be sure we are able to maintain and update the equipment as needed. We will gladly accept donations at any of the club meetings or directly via mail to:

Another note that the severe weather season is fast approaching and during severe weather the 146.76 will be used by WX9GRB the National Weather Service out for Green Bay.

During its use, WX9GRB will change the courtesy tone to WX during severe weather nets.

During a severe weather net only WX9GRB and the designated liaisons from the county nets are allowed to use the 146.76 repeater.

The 145.330 and the 443.650 repeaters are still available during a severe weather net for normal amateur use and we ask that you use those repeaters and stay off of the 146.76 during a severe weather net.
