

American Cancer Society's 5K Walk/Run – Sole Burner 2016

The FCARC will be conducting a controlled net with all communications traffic passing through the Net Control Station (NCS). All stations will be activated and released by the NCS. The NCS will use the call W9ZL when activated.

It is recommended that all operators wear their W9ZL safety vests if owned and stand in a visible or clear location with regards to the participants and with the proper orientation to the repeater.

Remember to bring the following if owned: extra batteries, folding lawn chair, Sun/Rain/Cold protection, cell phone and digital camera.

Emergency Traffic will have priority at all times.

Any medical situation that 911 is required to handle during this event the Operator, the Medical Team member or a Good Samaritan that calls 911 is advised to stay on location of the medical incident to assist the 911 operator with information they will be requesting from the scene. If this person (to call 911) is an Operator, remember HIPAA has very specific rules of passing personal medical information to the public. It is advised that the ONLY information that is passed on the net or to the NCS if there is a medical situation and that the 911 operator has been called. At this point the operator will be excused (deactivated) from Net Operations by the NCS to attend to the 911 traffic. When your services are no longer required by the 911 operator, please check back into the net for your next rotation (activated) by the NCS.

We, the FCARC Communication & Logistic Operators, watch the crowd of people walking/running for signs of stress or distress, rejoin lost parties and find lost items. The Police watch the road crossings and vehicular traffic for the purpose of traffic control. The police have indicated that we can return items used to control traffic (Barricades, barrels or tape) to their original location. It is a \$300.00 fine for removing or breaking a police blockade or police line for the purpose of civilian safety.

If you find yourself in a situation where a resident or motorist is removing these items please remain calm and focus on our mission, we're not law enforcement and they haven't given us the authority to arrest, detain or interfere. If you feel the resident or motorist is doing something unsafe for the event participants or the safety of the general public at large, please locate the nearest police officer or police liaison, if neither can be found ask your NCS for additional instructions.

The Appleton Police Department will be anticipating that 2nd Amendment activist will be present, please do not be alarmed at the brazen display of shoulder weapons or the carry of non-concealed weapons. If the situation merits police involvements please locate the nearest police officer or police liaison. However, always watch your 6!
