<u>Month/Date</u>	<u>Activity and Explanation</u>
January	Winter Field Day – We use this as a Get On The Air (GOTA) opportunity. Currently we only operate for a few hours on the first day, but it could be more in the future.
February	Awards Banquet – The Awards Banquet is a dinner event that is used to present awards, plaques, and other recognition to members of the club who have made contributions throughout the year. Dress is typically casual to semiformal.
March	WQP – The annual Wisconsin QSO Party sponsored by The West Allis ARC. The FCARC typically represents well in this event.
April	Walk MS – The first of many public service events the club is involved in. This event is held in and around Appleton North High. This is a springtime event – dress appropriately since operators are spread across the course.
May	American Cancer Society Soleburner – This event is held at city park in Appleton. Be prepared for massive crowds that fill the closed streets for as far as you can see. Again, be prepared for the weather and to do a bit of walking yourself! The event lasts about 4 hours.
June	Sunshine Swapfest – Our open air hamfest/swapfest. Come and buy, sell or just hang out. We expect this event to grow and grow. Food & drinks available.
	Appleton Flag Day Parade – An opportunity to showcase our club. ARRL Field Day – The premiere club event. Field Day is the hottest event the club has and turnout is high. Typically, the club operates HF voice, digital, CW, and VHF stations and attempts as many bonus points as possible. The event lasts 2 days.
July	Communityfest – This is Neenah’s 4 th of July celebration at Riverside Park. This event requires manning some roadblocks and safeguarding the fireworks setup at Doty Park (across the channel from Riverside Park). There are many jobs to do at Communityfest and it tends to be very warm. Bring the sunscreen! One day event lasting 12 + hours.
	EAA Airventure Special Events Station – The Experimental Aircraft Association’s Airventure – The biggest air show event in the world and we’re there with a special event station! Come operate or just rub elbows with all the hams that come to visit. Total event lasts 4+ days.
August	Corn Roast Picnic – Usually the club does not meet in August but instead has a corn roast picnic. Stay tuned to the website or your email inbox for specific locations and times. Event length is about 3-4 hours.
September	Wisconsin Parks On The Air (WIPOTA.com) – An FCARC sponsored operating contest designed to promote public awareness of ham radio within Wisconsin’s beautiful state park system. 3rd Saturday in September.
October	ST Joe’s – The last communication event of the season. This walk/run benefits the St Joe’s food pantry in Menasha. The St Joe course is a USA Track & Field certified course.
November	Hamfest – The FCARC Hamfest is held on the first Sunday of November every year. The event draws about 200-400 from around the country and sometimes the world!
December	Christmas Party – The club party is held immediately after the club meeting (and we do our best to keep the meeting short). This is a potluck event so bring a dish to pass.
